CALL FOR NOMINATIONS CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS FOUNDATION 2013 LIFE SCIENCES AWARDS

The Christopher Columbus Fellowship Foundation, a Federal government agency, with the mission of promoting and encouraging new discoveries, is now accepting Nominations for the Sixth Annual *Life Sciences Awards* to recognize, through **four** monetary awards, one scientist; one current high school educator; and two current high school students who are judged to exemplify excellence in life sciences.

\$10,000 Distinguished Life Sciences Scientist Award

The **\$10,000 Distinguished Life Sciences Scientist Award** will be presented to a scientist who is making or has recently made a significant and positive contribution toward the development of a "cutting edge" innovation in the field of life sciences.

\$5,000 Life Sciences Educator Award

The \$5,000 Life Sciences Educator Award will be presented to a current high school educator, with at least five years of teaching experience, who demonstrates an ongoing teaching strategy that evidences proficiency in instructing students in the College Board's Advanced Placement (AP) or International Baccalaureate (IB) Biology, Chemistry or other life sciences courses.

\$1,000 Life Sciences Student Awards

Two **\$1,000** Life Sciences Student Awards will be presented to current high school students who are making or have recently made significant and positive contributions related to the study of life science.
